

#### **How MCSTAP can Help & When to Call**

- Assistance with evidence-based practices when prescribing medication for treating chronic pain or SUD
- Consult on questions (managing meds a/o chronic pain):
  - Prescribing medication for Opioid Use Disorder MOUD)
    - Buprenorphine or Naltrexone
  - Review potential treatment plan changes prior to patient visit
    - Preparing for medication changes or titrating medications
  - Planning overall management of complex a/o challenging cases
  - Supporting care of pregnant women a/o special populations
- Identify resources to address patients' needs
- Coaching: on patients of all levels of complexity who have chronic pain a/o SUD (Case by case or longitudinal)
- Build a/o improve clinical capacity of clinician/practice to care for patients with chronic pain a/o SUD

## Real-time Consultation: Pediatric SUD resources from the Massachusetts Child Psychiatry Access Program (MCPAP)

In collaboration with the Boston Children's Hospital Adolescent Substance Use and Addiction Program (ASAP), MCPAP now offers:

- 1) **Real-time consultation** from a pediatric addiction medicine specialist (colleague to colleague)—call your regional MCPAP team and ask for ASAP.
- 2) Virtual counseling by an LICSW specializing in pediatric SUD, to support primary care based treatment for patients. Consultations are free; counseling appointments are billed to patient insurance through Boston Children's.

To access, PCPs should continue to call their regional MCPAP line and ask to connect with the ASAP team. The ASAP consultant on-call will speak with the PCP and determine if virtual substance use counseling would be appropriate for their patient. The ASAP-MCPAP staff will complete intake information and reach out to your patient to schedule the first appointment.
