- MassHealth requires that PCPs in ACOs are exclusive to that ACO plan, which is why PCPs cannot accept any other ACO, PCC, or MCO plan
- Primary care exclusivity only applies to ACOs.
- A primary care practice entity that contracts with an ACO may only empanel managed care members who are also enrolled in that same ACO and may only provide primary care services to managed care members who are also enrolled in that same ACO. They may not provide primary care services or empanel MassHealth managed care members enrolled in an MCO, the Primary Care Clinician (PCC) Plan, or any other ACO.
- Primary care exclusivity does not apply to PCPs serving members in the Special Kids Special Care Program.
- PCPs who contract with ACOs may continue to provide services to MassHealth FFS, OneCare, SCO, and PACE members regardless of their contracts with ACOs.
- Primary care exclusivity requirements neither apply to nor impact specialists, hospitals, and other providers—including behavioral health providers.
- Patient eligibility should always be confirmed in the MassHealth MMIS portal
