## **“The Role Clinicians Play in Protecting the Health of Private Well Owners”**

### **Steve Wilson, MS**

is a groundwater hydrologist and Head of the Environmental Public Health, Information and Data Services Section at the Illinois State Water Survey, University of Illinois. He authored and manages *The Private Well Class*, an online self-paced curriculum for private well owners. He recently assisted the American Academy of Pediatrics in updating their policy statement and technical guidance on private wells. Steve has a B.S. in Agricultural Engineering and a M.S. in Civil Engineering from the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign.

Mr. Wilson will include a discussion of the public health issues surrounding private well owners and drinking water. He will summarize the research on clinicians' success in encouraging testing of private well water and outline the steps clinicians can take to support their patients who use private wells.
